- Pot Plants should be presented in one pot, no fancy outer pot. The pot, should not exceed 30 cm in diameter and must be nice and clean, and the plant should be in the middle of the pot. Hanging containers not to exceed 35 cm diameter.

\* Use a standard sized saucer with sand as damp as possible without water running out. Form into a dome 3-4 cm high at the middle. Arrange flowers in alternating circles. Work from the middle with one or two flowers in the centre of the mound and work evenly downwards. Use the flowers you have least of first so when you get near the bottom you will have enough of the same type of flower to go all the way around the saucer.)

\*\* Design of dried horticultural materials glued to a firm backing (Heavy cardboard or light plywood) no more than 30 cm x 20 cm.
