- Conducted under the Show Rules of CatsWA, which may be obtained from the CatsWA Website, Office (9452 2885) or from the Secretary.
- Non-CatsWA members must send a copy of the exhibit's Registration Certificate with entry. As this is a restricted show, Cat of the Year points will not be awarded.
- The show will be held in a tent which will mean that cages will be in close proximity to each other. Please consider if your cat will be comfortable in this environment before entering the show. Please note that lack of space will restrict entries to the first 30 entries received.
- Show catalogues are provided to exhibitors free of charge
- Exhibitors are required to be at the venue/contactable by phone for the duration of the show. If the weather is exceptionally hot, the show may close early. Please note that cats may NOT be removed from the show before 5.00 pm unless pre-arranged with the OPAS Show secretary.
- This is a BYO Cage show – cages can be purchased from the CatsWA office. Litter will be provided, but please provide a litter tray, water dish and something for your cat to sit on in the cage.
- The age of all cats shall be computed from the day of their birth to midnight before the first day of the show. If the day of birth is not known its age, for the purpose of exhibition, shall be taken as the first day of the month of birth.
- Domestic/Companion kittens & cats over the age of six months must be desexed
- Owners wishing to show their Domestic cats at a CatsWA show need to be a financial member of an ACF (Inc), CCCA (Inc) affiliate or a member of ANCA.

 N-MK7 Male (entire or neuter) kitten 5 months and under 7 months

N-FK9 Female (entire or spey) kitten 7 months and under 9 months

N-MK9 Male (entire or neuter) kitten 7 months and under 9 months
