- Exhibits and entry forms to be delivered: Thursday 16th November (6.30 pm-8.30 pm), Friday 17th November (10.00 am-4.00 pm) or Saturday 18th November (7.00 am-9 am) (Early entry forms: 6th November)
- Exhibitors enter through Gate No 4, Royal Street, Tuart Hill (see map)
- Judging will commence: 10 am Saturday.

- Only bona fide hobbyists are eligible to exhibit, and all eggs must be home produced.
- Eggs should be clean, but not washed, or oiled. (One egg per entry will be randomly chosen and broken by the judge to determine the quality of its contents).
 - Judging: External - cleanliness, shape, size and weight, and uniformity of exhibit. Internal - colour, consistency, freshness, texture and volume.
